Call for Nominations

The Vernon C. Bulgrin
High School Chemistry Teacher Award
Wyoming Section, American Chemical Society

The purpose of this award is to recognize outstanding teaching of chemistry by a Wyoming high school teacher.

The award will consist of a cash prize, the exact amount to be determined by the Awards Committee, and a plaque.

Any Wyoming high school science teacher who has taught high school chemistry for at least two years is eligible for the award.

Nominations for the award may be made by the Section High School Liaison Committee, any member of the Wyoming Section, or by any high school teacher or administrator. Nominees will be asked to submit an application and three letters of recommendation will be required. Consideration will be given to such activities as participation in the Chemistry Olympiad, National Chemistry Week, the State Science Fair, professional workshops, and to other evidence of teaching excellence.

All nominations and applications should be received by the Awards Committee by April 1.

Applications will be reviewed by the Awards Committee of the Wyoming Section which shall forward its recommendation to the Executive Committee of the Wyoming Section for final action.

The formal presentation of the award will be made at the Annual Wyoming Section Spring Awards Banquet. The awardee will be invited to attend the banquet.
